

Christian Lifestyle Commitment

The ministry of Emmanuel Christian High School is not the same as the ministry of the local church. Although we praise the Lord when He uses us to bring a lost person to a saving knowledge of Christ, the Christian school was established for the academic development of Christian young people who wish to follow the Lord's will in their lives. As a Christian school, there are many standards which we follow that not all public and private schools hold to. Many of these standards apply to the students only while they are at school, but some also demonstrate lifestyle. Page 8 of the school handbook reads:

“While Emmanuel Christian School does not have the right to control the behavior of the students off campus, it does have the responsibility to determine whether a student behaving in a certain manner as a style of life will continue to attend the school. Students who follow a lifestyle inappropriate to the witness of the school may be asked to withdraw.”

Simply stated, we expect our students to live a Christian lifestyle both at school and away from school. Behavior which has placed a child in trouble with the legal system and inappropriate behavior including the use of profanity, tobacco, alcohol, illegal drugs or involvement in sexual promiscuity is contrary to the moral teaching of God's Word and is totally inappropriate for any of our students at any time. Although God forgives all confessed sin, involvement in the above activities changes a person's lifestyle from that of a child to that of an adult. Since this is a school for children, to attend Emmanuel Christian High School, each student must commit to and follow this Christian lifestyle.
