

KINDERGARTEN SUPPLEMENT FOR THE HANDBOOK:

Age to enter K3-K5:

When entering K3 through K5 your child must be the appropriate age for the class he/she is to enter before October 1. No exceptions will be made.

When filling out the Student Release Authorization form for your child, please be sure to list the names of people that will be allowed to pick up your child and any telephone numbers needed in case of emergencies. If names or numbers on your child's Student Release Authorization form change during the year, please contact the office to update any changes.

All students in kindergarten must be potty trained:

We ask that you send an extra set of clothes with your child in case of spilling a liquid on themselves or wetting their pants on accident. We ask that all clothing be labeled with your child's name inside the clothing. The extra clothes need to consist of a shirt, socks, underwear, shorts and long pants. The reason for short and long pants is to meet the need of your child regardless of the type of weather there happens to be that day.

If a wetting accident happens and the child has extra clothes, they will be allowed to go into the bathroom and change clothes. If the child needs assistance putting on their clothes the teacher will stand outside and hand the clothes under the stall to the child.

Nap Time:

Students that stay from 11:30 to 3:00 will participate in nap time. For nap time your child will need a Kid-Napper. The students are to sleep or lay quietly on their Kid-Napper during this time.

Snacks for after school care:

The child may bring a snack or purchase a snack for .40 through the school.

If through the course of a day, you realize your child will need to stay for after school care, you may call the office and order a snack over the phone. The snack may be paid for when you pick up your child. We never want a child to go hungry.

Pickup time:UB

When picking up your child at 11:30, place your child's class card on the passenger side dashboard of your car. If for any reason someone other than yourself or someone on the Student Authorization form will be picking up your child, please send a note stating the name of the person. We do prefer a note, but in case of an emergency you may call the school office if you are sending someone not on the authorization form.
